

# CORBYS GLEN PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting held on Wed. 14<sup>th</sup> January 2010 in the Willoughby Art Gallery.

Present : Cllrs. Honeywood (Chairman), Gardner, Tutt, Kiely, & Lamming  
In attendance : Miss D Balsler (Parish Clerk) and 1 resident.

1. **Apologies for absence** B Grantham & B Johnson
2. **District and County Councillors' Reports** Nothing to report
3. **Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2009**  
Were signed correct
4. **Councillors' Declarations of Interest** None declared
5. **Matters for report arising from the minutes :**
  - 30/03 **Access across Village Green** No change.
  - 12/08 **Barleycroft/Pridmore Road streetlight** The installation of the lights has been held up due to weather conditions and will be done asap
  - 14/08 **W.I. Oak Trees** No changes reported - has been held up due to current weather conditions.
  - 09/02 **Allotments** Cllrs were informed that we are unable to obtain suitable land from Grimsthorpe. The Clerk was asked to send letters to other local land owners with the hope that they may have suitable land for allotments.
  - 29/07 **Christmas Tree** Cllr Honeywood expressed his thanks to Cllrs Kiely and Lamming with their help of the erection and dismantling of the Christmas tree. It was agreed that another strip of lights would be purchased, which will allow for an improved display this year.
  - 31/09 **Tendering for Grass Cutting** Cllr Kiely informed the meeting that a revised quote had been received from Rick Webster, and it was agreed that we would continue with his service for the coming year.
  - 32/09 **Community Cleaner** New cleaners have started. The Clerk was asked to chase up the grant facility from SKDC
  - 33/09 **Precept** The precept form had been signed and submitted to SKDC
  - 34/09 **Station Road Footpaths (SH)** Cllr Honeywood informed the council that we are still waiting to hear from the resident regarding the letter from Highways.
  - 35/09 **Willoughby Gallery lights** Cllrs Kiely advised no further work needs to be carried out at this moment.
  - 36/09 **Play Equipment – Village Green** Work will take place to clean the play surface subject to weather permitting.

**37/09 Dyke on Tanner's Lane** The clerk circulated correspondence received from a local landowner and SKDC. It was noted that SKDC is responsible for maintaining the section of dyke in question, and that work to clean that section will be carried out in the spring. It was also noted that maintenance of the section of dyke further up Tanners Lane is the responsibility of the adjacent landowners, as a riparian responsibility.

**38/09 Footpath Barleycroft Road** Cllr's were advised of the email received from SKDC Highways, stating that they will be replace and re-tarmac the area asap.

**6. Circulated correspondence** Cllr's were told of the resignation of Mr Desmond Adcock as Internal Auditor, due to reduced eyesight. The Clerk was asked to write to Mr Adcock to express thanks for the service he has provided. It was agreed that a notice would be put on the notice board, to advertise for a replacement Auditor.

Cllr's also discussed the temporary closure of the Coachman Inn, following receipt of e-mail correspondence and expressed their concerns. Local residents had complained to the council over the blocked footpath, the temporary lights, and the noise generated from the generator. The Clerk had written to the landlords asking if they would keep the council up to date on the situation, and to advise when the problems are expected to be resolved, enabling the pub to open again.

**7. Reports from Sub-committees : Planning** Cllrs discussed the planning permission granted for a house on St John's Drive, adjacent to the Glenside Surgery.
